I would like to begin my first newsletter by thanking Minister Arthur Plumpton for his continuous hard work, commitment and dedication to the Chair of SNUi for the past three years. I understand from committee colleagues that his technical skills have led us forward to where we are now. I know he was a great support and encouraged his team to explore their strengths. Today, we are witnessing a 320% increase in membership in the first month of lockdown and a four-fold increase in attendees at SNUi events, which is a great achievement. Arthur's technical skills and insight played a major role for this to happen.

We are entering into an exciting time where we need to improve upon some of the teaching and demonstrations in order for us to progress in both quality and standards. I see my role as one of motivator; to drive us all forward by opening more opportunities to our members. Also, hopefully, helping to maintain the quality of speakers, demonstrators, healers and teachers on SNUi platforms and classes. I can now announce that from January, 2021, only those new exponents who have achieved their PASi qualification will be able teach and/or demonstrate mediumship. I have managed to avoid technology for years but through this lockdown, I have been forced to change and learn very basic technical skills. I can now confess that I enjoy my online work and can see the great potential for growth that is now afforded us.

I am so inspired by the work of SNUi. To think that anyone, anywhere can have access to all our events and classes fills me with wonder. Never again need I hear those words, 'There's nothing happening near where I live', or 'it's not possible to join a development

group in my area'. We have so much to offer everyone, no matter where. Yes, temporarily, there may be problems with translation but 'where there's a will, there's a way.'

I have great enthusiasm and passion and I hope to bring these to SNUi. I have always loved my work as a healer, medium, trance medium and teacher. I will, of course still be around within the SNUi as I hold dear the objectives of the organisation.

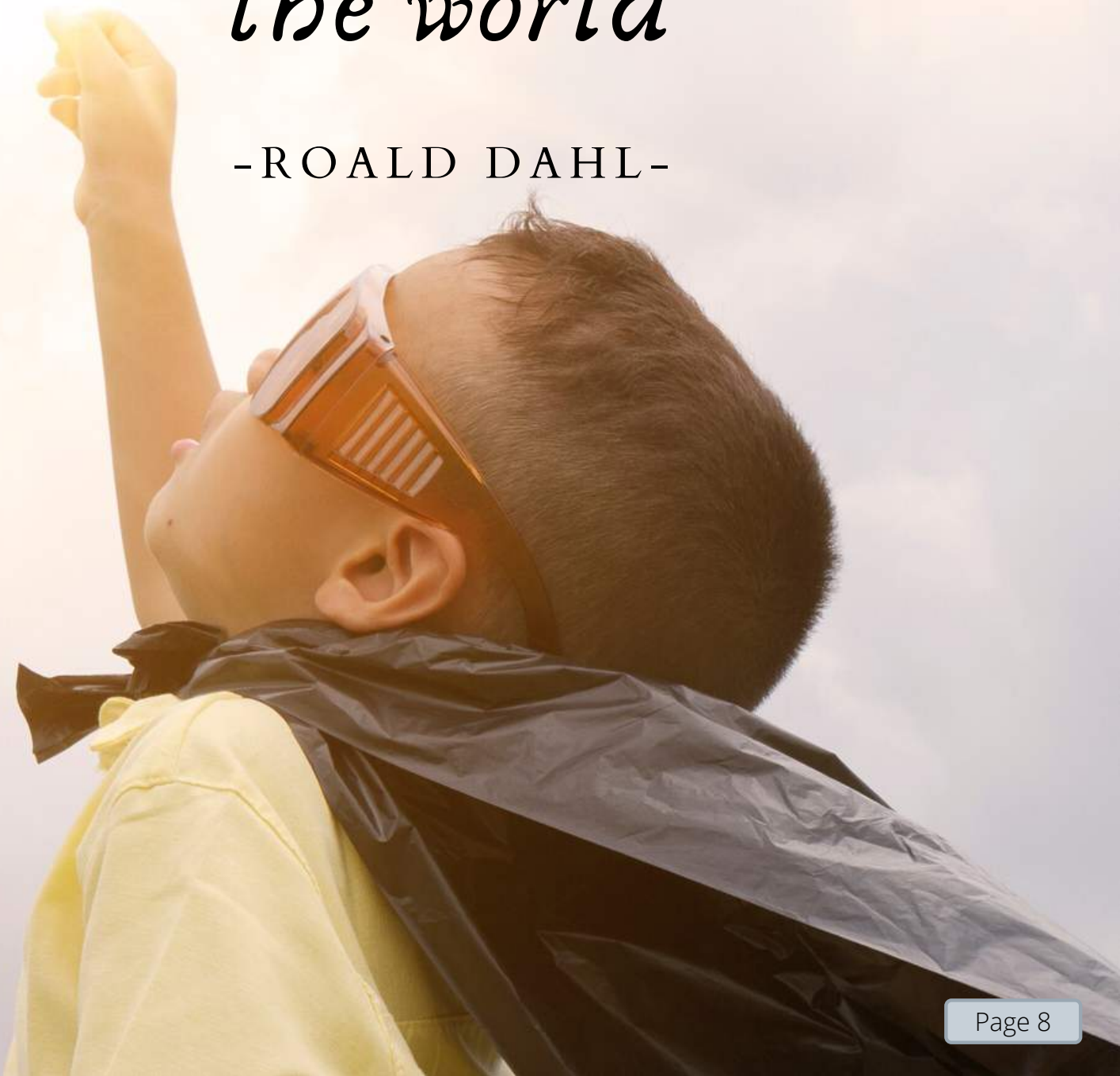
I want to take this opportunity to thank all those who have supported our direction over the last 10 years and wish all of you the success you have worked so hard to achieve.

Seventh Principle



Eternal Progress
Open to Every
Human Soul

"WE UNDERSTAND FROM THE SEVENTH PRINCIPLE THAT GOD DOES NOT EVER TURN HIS FACE AWAY FROM US. WE ARE HIS CHILDREN AND HE LOVES US. HE DOES NOT GIVE UP ON US NO MATTER WHAT WE HAVE DONE OR HOW LITTLE WE HAVE LEARNED. THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT GOD CONDONES OR APPROVES OF INJURIOUS BEHAVIOUR OR INIQUITOUS ACTIONS, BUT RATHER THAT HE IS PATIENT WITH US AND WITH OUR FAILINGS AND GIVES US THE CHANCE TO REDEEM OURSELVES OVER TIME. THE LENGTH OF TIME IT WILL TAKE DOES NOT CONCERN HIM; WHAT IS OF GREATER IMPORTANCE IS THAT WE ARE WILLING TO TAKE ACTION TO MAKE IMPROVEMENT."

"It is our responsibility to accept that there is further progress to be made and work to be done in order to achieve greater spiritual evolution. We are given unlimited time in which to develop our spiritual potential and as we unfold we shall find ourselves sharing the companionship of those enlightened souls who have been charged with the task of assisting us on our way. As we journey onward with these spirit helpers we shall enter spheres of ever-increasing spiritual evolution and knowledge...The level of progression of a soul is defined by the quality and brightness of its spiritual light and purity. SELF-DEVELOPMENT: THE KEY TO UNLOCKING OUR POTENTIAL

DO YOU FEEL WE SPEND ENOUGH TIME DEDICATED TO SELF-DEVELOPMENT?

Our worth is more than just the faculty of mediumship alone; there is more to us than this, and we have more to offer our communities and the world around us. There is a service we offer to others; yet, it is important we recognise we must make time to be of service to ourselves too. Looking after "number one" ensures we have the strength to look after number two, three, and four, etc.

Self-development has become a buzz word in many respects and is spoken of widely; this has been long awaited, but the question is how do we self-develop? Well, initially reflection of our own life needs to be explored; so, we can recognise the areas we feel change could happen. Many of us do not spend enough or any time doing this. Once identified, finding teachers who can guide and support the student in their own self-development would be highly beneficial. They can offer insight to identify the relevant pathway of self-reflection, and further study of Self, as well as mediumship development. Spiritualism is not just for developing mediums, healers, and speakers; it holds a truth to all and for all...to find their truth.

HOW MUST WE DEVELOP OURSELVES AS SPIRITUALISTS?

The principles themselves were brought through to help mankind, can be used as a guidance, and have the potential to Spiritualise and transform lives. There are keys within each principle that can unlock the potential of self and Soul purpose. Self-development through Spiritualism and its principles is still waiting to be more fully discovered.

Because we are an expression of God through our unity of humankind (brotherhood of Man); through our interactions and through our being, we are personally responsible for developing ourselves. Our developing is the expression of God.

If we took the time to sit in the power, we would see it stirs the Soul. When our Soul stirs, it ignites the purpose within us. And, when the purpose within us is added to the disciplining of ourselves, we can move ourselves deeper into our awareness of Soul purpose and potential.

We are never disconnected from the God force, although the conscious mind can make us feel disconnected through stresses, anxieties, and distractions etc. We need to acknowledge we are part of, and not separate to, God. Sitting in the Power creates space and acknowledgement for this; by acknowledging the wholeness and being of the Spirit within; this is where we are in oneness with the pure love of the Great Spirit...no beginning...and no ending...just eternal.

AS HUMANS, WHAT ARE SOME AREAS WITHIN OURSELVES WHICH REQUIRE MORE ILLUMINATION?

We must be open to change when information is presented, when found, so we can progress. We must learn to be discerning in order to listen to the Soul. It is important we find our power within rather than search for God replacements outside of ourselves.

When we release the conditions we place on others, when we look at whether we truly love or love with conditions, we may find the reality of our thoughts, deeds, and actions reveal a truth of intent; which in turn, is empowering in personal growth and understanding. When we go within, whilst in the chaos, we are able to look at personal development and discover our God -replacements. From here, we can learn to deepen our discernment, our own intuition, to weather through the storm; whatever it may be.

IN YOUR EXPERIENCE, WHAT DO YOU SUGGEST SO WE MAY GO DEEPER INTO UNDERSTANDING OURSELVES?

This gives us the ability to progress into our own awareness. We then are on a journey of understanding the philosophy of our own Soul; which then, enables us to understand the Souls of others, incarnate and discarnate.

When we are in the true essence of our power, we become the expression to ourselves; to our families, friends and communities; as well as in our mediumship. If we sit in the chaos; within the eye of the storm, this gives us Soul time; to strengthen and acknowledge the light within. A communion of Soul and Spirit that work together like "seamless cogs of eternity."

Through this transformation, healing can be generated; yet, we must remember healing can be messy, painful and tough. We struggle through, through the storm, into the peace; and the only way out, is through. We have to acknowledge, too, counselling or therapy may be encouraged whilst going through this transformation.

What is this death but a negligible accident?*

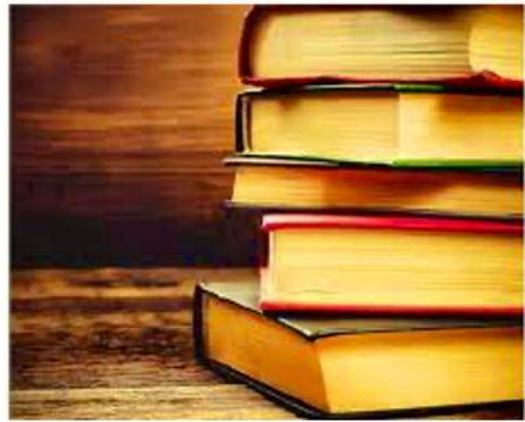

WHAT BROUGHT YOU TO SPIRITUALISM AND TO SNUi?

After my mum passed in March 2019 I began my exploration of Mediumship and Spiritualism by attending my first Mediumship Development Workshop; where I experienced what I thought was my first direct communion with Spirit. I then realised that I had been speaking with Spirit for as long as I could remember. This led me to join some local development circles and become a member of the SNU & SNUi. I attended the Barbanell Centre early last year for a Trance Healing course and then later in the year I attended the Arthur Findlay College for a Healing week. I knew that my great grandmother had given readings using a crystal ball, and I recall seeing this crystal ball as a child. I also knew of other family members with similar abilities. I then joined a local church in the UK and became a member and enrolled on the SNU Healing Accreditation Scheme (HAS), and following my induction I became a fully signed up member of a Spiritualists' Church.

I came about the SNUi following joining the SNU and attended a few classes.

WHAT HAS BEEN YOUR JOURNEY THROUGH SNUi?

After attending a few classes on the SNUi with some really inspiring and supportive tutors I was then drawn to enrol on the Platform Accreditation Scheme (PASi) and decided to undertake this via the SNUi. I have now completed all my PASi Speaking & Demonstrating practice and have applied for the Final Assessment Board. I was invited to coordinate the Student Divine Services (PASi) and then later to edit the SNUi Programme. I have recently taken on these two new roles and have become increasingly involved in the work of the SNUi. After completing the SD1 course, I took on the role of a TPS1 tutor. I am now studying the SD4 course and take part in the Weekly Presentations of Mediumship and the SNUi Divine Services.

WHAT EXCITES YOU ABOUT YOUR NEW ROLE?

I enjoy working with the SNUi team and helping to add value to the work of the SNUi. I like working with the PASi students and supporting them on their journey with the SNUi and beyond. 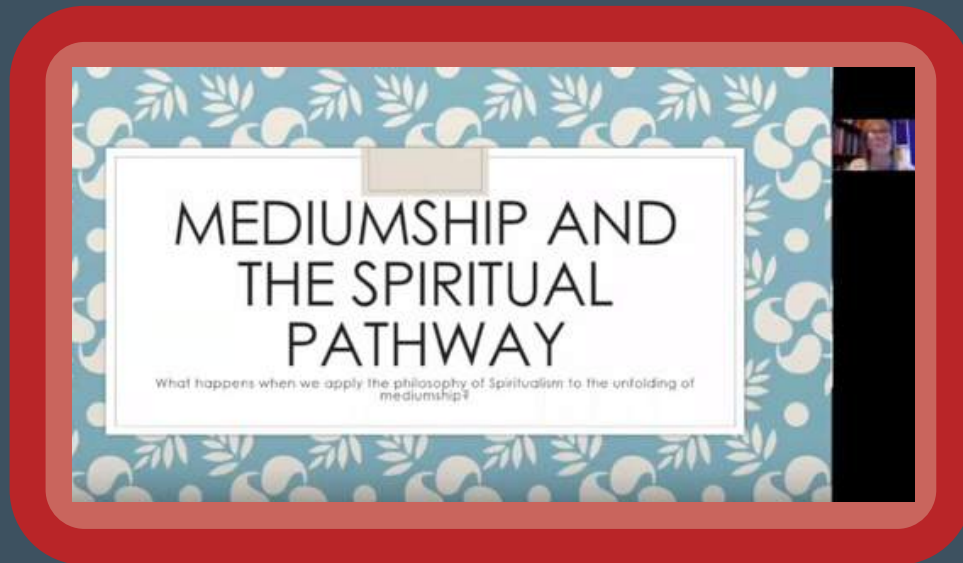

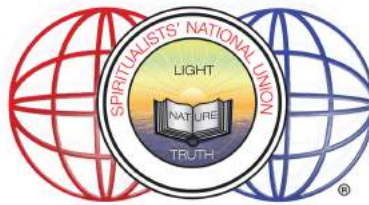

Cleansing all, making anew

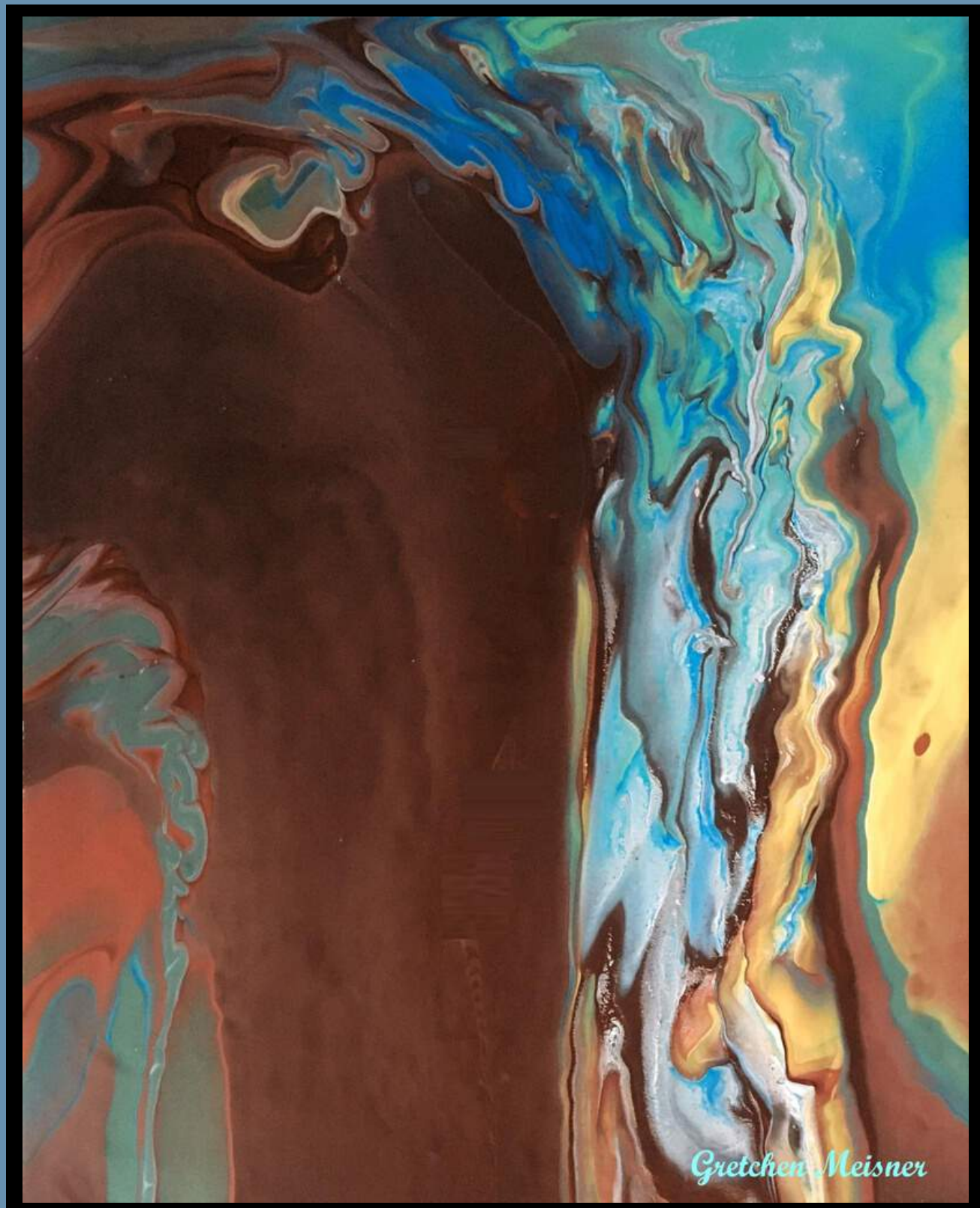
